SIGN-IN

All cars need to be pre-registered online to avoid Late Entry Fee All cars must pass safety before completing sign in process All cars must be signed in to practice.

All cars must be sign in and pass safety by Tuesday, Nov 26 at 12:00 pm to pull a pill used to determine heats.

Sign in will close Tuesday, Nov 26 at 12:15 pm

RACE FORMAT

Driver Radio Communication is required.

Practice- Maximum 7 cars, 2 minutes. 2 rounds time permitting Heat Line Ups by pill draw.

All races will have a time limit to be determined on race day. (If ModWF & Half drivers do not complete heat race prior to time limit, the cars will not refuel. The race will conclude with the 100-lap fuel limit.) The race finish will be determined on the next yellow/red flag that is thrown after the time limit has expired. The tower will score the finish by the last line up after the yellow/red flag.

Rookie classes are **NON-COMPETITIVE.** Race format will be the same as other classes.

Heats and Main Laps

All races will be run **HOT OUT OF THE CHUTE.** (**NO WARM UP LAPS**). Corner workers cars 1 – 4 in corresponding corner.

Heat Races will be 20 laps

Lower Mains will be 25 laps

Novice A Mains will be 25 laps. Lowers 15 laps.

A Mains will be 30 laps Juniors/ 40 laps Seniors

Classes with one car will run green, white, checkered flag.

Transfers to Mains will be determined by passing points.

There will be NO X CARS (break cars) in ANY MAIN.

Work Rule

All cars will be given maximum 3 courtesy laps for repairs. Courtesy laps to be allowed ONE TIME PER CAR PER RACE. Courtesy laps will start once the flagger has the restart line up set. There is no carryover of unused courtesy laps in the race.

<u>Tech</u>

All engines will be sealed immediately after Heat race.
Handlers are responsible for their engine sealing by a track official.
Top three finishers in each class will be impounded after the Main Event.
All cars signed in are subject to tech at any time during the event.

Fuel/Tires

Mandatory fuel: Chevron midgrade 89 purchased at Chevron 4610 W Tropicana Ave. Corner of Tropicana Ave and Cameron.

No Fuel Containers over 5 gallons. 5# Fire Extinguishers Must be at ALL TRAILERS(NV fire marshal). Fuel and oil may be checked at Tech's discretion. AA's and Half's will have a 5-minute time limit to refuel during mains. All drivers not ready to race when time expires will be sent to the pits and will start at the back, if they return before the green flag.

All drivers participating in the A main will purchase a tire voucher online. These are the required tires, that must be utilized during the A main event. Tires will be marked and\or branded across the racing surface of the tire to ensure no alteration of the tire takes place prior to the race. Tires may be mounted at your trailer. When handler/driver comes to staging the brand must be on the tire and tires must still be in "virgin" condition. Tires not meeting the "virgin" criteria must be replaced with another set purchased at the designated location. Tires must remain untouched, no grinding, scotch brite, needling, sanding, etc... Cars will enter staging/track on unaltered "virgin" tires.

Awards—Competitive classes

Heat race winners will receive an award.

1st -3rd place A Main events will receive a custom slot machine.

1st place A Main will receive a checkered flag.

Non-Competitive Rookie

Heat race winners will receive an award.

1st place A Main will receive a checkered flag.

All Rookies will receive an award. **Pre-registered Rookie** a small custom slot machine.
